Here's how to wash Ddelicates with Charlie's Soap:

- The machine should be cleaned of all residues of other detergents before washing your clothes in Charlie's Soap. Put 2 TBSP of the Powder or 2 Fl. Oz. of the Liquid into the machine and some old rags and run a full cycle with a double rinse. If you're already using Charlie's Soap for everything, you can skip this step.
- Follow care instructions on your garment with regard to water temperature, agitation and drying.
- When in doubt, use the full amount of Charlie's Soap for a load: 1 Fl. Oz. for the Liquid or 1 TBSP for the Powder. Charlie's Soap will rinse completely so there is no need to worry about residue.
- For a small load using less water, you could get by with 3/4 dose. Call for info if you have hard water.
- Clothes that have been washed in anything other than Charlie's Soap likely have detergent residues. These residues were designed to stick, and it may take several washes in Charlie's Soap to remove them. The more you wash with Charlie's Soap, the cleaner your garments become.
